We have been asked to share the following message from Scottish Government with our parents and carers.

The second document highlighted in this message is what we are basing our recovery planning on and more information will be shared with you as soon as we can. We have a complex task ahead and I would ask for your patience and understanding as we navigate our way through all the most recent information to allow us to plan for a restart in August.

As you may already be aware, following the publication of a route map document today which outlines the Scottish Government's planned future response to the COVID19 Pandemic – <https://www.gov.scot/publications/coronavirus-covid-19-framework-decision-making-scotlands-route-map-through-out-crisis/> the First Minister has announced, that the Scottish Government is currently planning for the reopening of Scottish schools on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2020.
