General Advice

Maths is best studied by tackling questions as opposed to reading through work. A little and often is better than cram and leave for several days. Set aside time on at least 4 days per week to focus on maths, get used to working without the distraction of phones, etc. like it is in the exam.

And remember, **you gain marks in an exam you do not lose them**. If the examiner can't see your working (even if you don't finish a question) they have nothing to mark.

Finally... it is important to have breaks and relax after a block of intense revision
